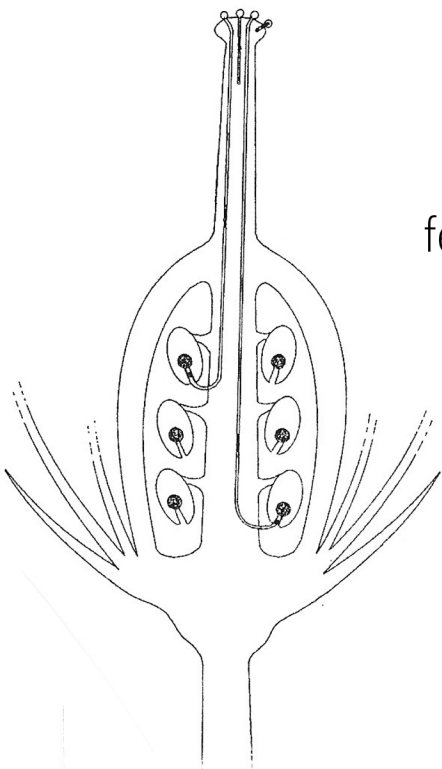
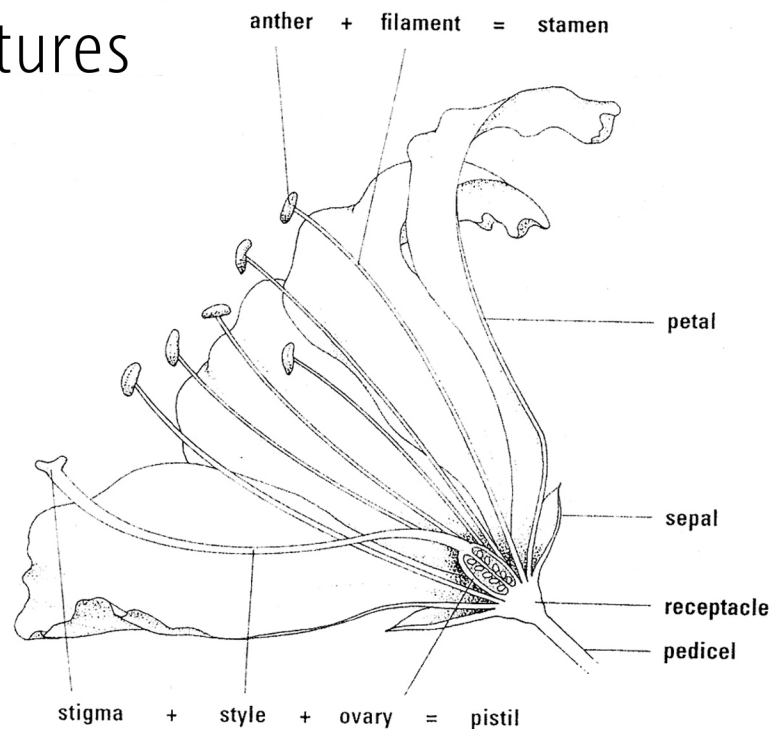
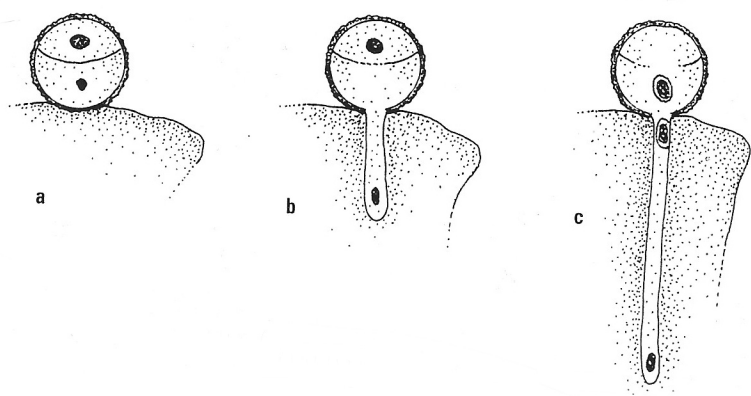


Typical Flower Structures

1. Pollen grains land on the stigma and germinate.
2. Pollen tubes, through which the sperm move, grow through the style. A tube nucleus precedes the sperm in each pollen tube.
3. A pollen tube enters each ovule to deliver the sperm to an awaiting egg.
